Our workshop is accessible to approved members and is primarily used for community "build projects", but also available for personal projects. There is a one month orientation period. Annual one year membership fee is \$50 payable following this orientation period; half year or less, membership fee is \$25.

Everyone, except children under 6 years, are welcome to visit and participate in many of our Shed activities as guests. Children over 6 years must be accompanied by two adults, one of whom must be a member.

For workshop capacity and safety reasons, members must accompany their guest(s) (maximum of two).
